This week's newsletter is coming out a day earlier than usual so we can share information with you without bombarding you.

Today, our school moved into Covid Alert Level 2 until at least Friday midnight. We have a health and safety plan in place - a copy is in the office should you wish to view it. The main points are:

- A return to parent drop off and pick up at the gate
- Limiting visitors to our school
- Renewal of reminders about our handwashing and hand sanitising regime.
- One metre distancing - particularly for anyone coming into school, but we are also teaching our children about this.
- Mandatory Contact tracing for all who enter the school gates.
- Assemblies cancelled.
- **Bus - Travel as usual** - children will be hand sanitised on and off the bus

School continues as usual with extra cleaning and sanitising precautions in place. I'd just like to reinforce how important it is for you to all be using the contact tracing app on your phones. This is the one way we can be assured everyone involved can be notified should the need arise. School QR codes are in the office and on the letterbox.

It's really important that any children showing signs of illness are kept home. Should children develop any symptoms at school, we will notify you and ask you to come and pick them up.

We are hoping that this week's planned senior assembly will be able to be moved to next week - dependent upon the situation however. We will continue to update you as things progress or change.

Just a reminder of our school bus Code of Conduct
which parents sign on behalf of the younger children.
The older children sign alongside the parents.

Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct is between _____ (student),
_____ (their caregiver)
and Carew Peel Forest School (school / bus operator).

The caregiver and the student should ensure they have read and understood this document, which is to be adhered to for the safety of the bus driver and all students travelling on the school bus.

I, _____ (student), agree to abide by the behavioural expectations described below:

- When I am a seated passenger, I will remain in my seat for the whole journey.
- I will not eat on the bus or throw anything inside or out of the bus.
- I will respect other students and their property at all times (this includes pushing, verbal or physical abuse, or any other behaviour that may distract the driver).
- I will use socially acceptable language when conversing with the driver and/or other students and I will not speak at a volume that may distract the driver.
- I will respect the property on the bus at all times (e.g. refraining from standing on seats or vandalising the vehicle in any way).
- I will not engage in any behaviour that could put the driver or other students at risk.
- I will observe the requirements and instructions of the bus driver and the teacher/s responsible for bus duty at all times.
- I understand that any damage I cause to the bus will result in my caregiver being billed for the cost of repairs.

The safety and comfort of everyone on the bus depends on a standard of behaviour and consideration for others that is expected in the classroom. We hope that caregivers will support the school in maintaining these standards of behaviour.

IF THIS CODE OF CONDUCT IS BROKEN:

- The student will be placed on daily report for one week and the caregiver will be notified immediately
- If no improvement is evident after one week, an interview will be arranged between the student, caregiver(s), and school.
- If there is still no improvement, travel on a school bus will be withdrawn, and the caregiver will be required to find alternative transport to get the student to school.
- In extreme cases of misbehaviour the privilege of travelling on a school bus could be withdrawn immediately.
