We know when parents have arrived, where you can find your child/ren and it leaves the big gate clear for the bus. Due to the success of this we will continue with this beyond Level 2, however we will be able to move the pick up of children to within the school gates which will save the bottleneck at the gate.

We are currently finalising dates for a parent teacher meeting and we will be offering both face to face or online meetings depending on what you prefer. This is our opportunity to report to you and to gather your perspective on your child's progress. 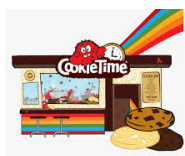

FOOD HEAT UP'S

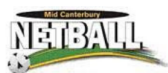
Due to the cold weather food heat up's are available on Monday, Wednesday & Friday's.
