Proposed Split of Combined Board of Trustees

The Geraldine High School and Carew Peel Forest School Combined Board of Trustees has been, since April this year, consulting with our school community on the proposal to split the combined board.

The Board would like to thank the school community, especially those in the Carew Peel Forest area, for their engagement in this consultation and we would like to acknowledge the genuine concerns and apprehension shared with us. The consultation also clearly demonstrated the passion and commitment the community has to the wellbeing of both schools, not to mention the wealth of capable and engaged community members.

With all of that in mind, the Board of Trustees has made the decision to recommend to the Minister of Education that the Combined Board of Trustees be disbanded and separate boards of trustees be formed for each of Carew Peel Forest School and Geraldine High School.

It is important to be aware this is only a recommendation and there are also no set timeframes in which the Minister must respond or actions be taken.

In the meantime the existing board continues to operate as it has for both schools.
