### **Kia ora.**

We are looking forward to our family fun day tomorrow. Children are able to wear their house colours to school - uniforms not required. A few reminders about the day:

Can all parents please meet us in the school domain for an 11.30 start. We will assemble in our care crews at the school and then head across the road. Please park well clear of the gates - we need good visibility when crossing the road. Extra parking is available in the hall carpark if needed.

We start the event in our four care crews. We will then have a competitive race which is held in year groups (Y5/6, Y3/4, Y1/2). The competitive race is opt in - children can join in if they want. If numbers are high in each group, we will look towards splitting them further. The final event will be for adults for those who are keen. Children will then move into class groups.

If you wish to take responsibility for your children following the races (and while children are eating), please get them signed off with their classroom teacher. We will ensure children bring their bags/lunchboxes over to the domain so we don't have lots of children needing to cross the road.

Hand sanitiser will be available at the domain entry gates for use prior to eating. Handwashing and toilet facilities are at school.

***Please supervise children at all times when crossing the road.***

The best place to watch the races is from the centre of the domain. Children will be running a circuit around the perimeter.

The forecast is for cold weather so please rug up warmly and ensure children have warm jumpers/jackets particularly following their events.

Sausages are available for purchase \$1 each. Please have the correct change if possible. You are welcome to bring picnic lunches also.

Buses are not running as we expect children will go home with their parents following the event. If you are unable to be there, please let us know urgently so we can arrange transport.

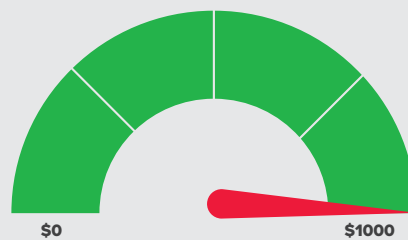
